KPH to receive donation of Cardiovascular Rehabilitation Equipment from Zion Care International

The Kingston Public Hospital is to receive a donation of \$ in Cardiovascular equipment from Zion Care International. This equipment is vital in the recovery of persons who suffer Cardiovascular health issues. Cardiovascular Disease is one the major causes of death in Jamaica, the equipment is being donated to the KPH providing equipment that is not usually available to patients of a public hospital. Training of the KPH Hospital staff to use the machines was arranged on-line by Zion Care through a collaboration with partners at the Montefiore Hospital in Bronx New York who provided On- line training to the staff of KPH. Zion Care International, which is led by Jamaican-born Dr Bishop Craig Brown who has been doing charity work by providing equipment to Jamaican Health Institutions and has also led Dental and Medical Missions here over the last 12 years.

Zion Care got the equipment donated and the cost of shipping them, to Jamaica, \$ was covered by the National Health Fund and the Jamaica Medical Foundation.
